**COURT ORDER
ORDERED ON 02 FEBRUARY 2016**

1. The applicant is admitted as *amicus* in terms of SCA rule 16 and subject to its provisions.
2. The applicant's heads of arguments are limited to 30 pages.
3. The applicant must, in particular, observe SCA rule 16(7) and (8).
4. The decision to permit oral argument will be taken by the presiding judge.
5. If oral argument is permitted it will be limited to 30 minutes.
6. The heads of argument must be filed within 10 days following the respondent's heads of argument.
7. The party affected by the heads may file heads in response by no later than 7 days following the filing of the Heads referred to in para 4.
8. The costs incurred by or as a result of the intervention of the *amicus* shall be decided by the court hearing the appeal.
9. The Applicant is permitted to file and deliver an application to place further evidence before the Supreme Court of Appeal. The decision to admit such evidence shall be taken by the Court hearing the appeal.
